Location

In northern Europe, on the east side of the Scandinavian Peninsula, with coastline on the North and Baltic seas and the Gulf of Bothnia. Neighbours Norway on the East. Mountains along Northwest border cover 25 per cent of Sweden. Flat or rolling terrain covers central and southern areas which includes several large lakes.

Capital: Stockholm

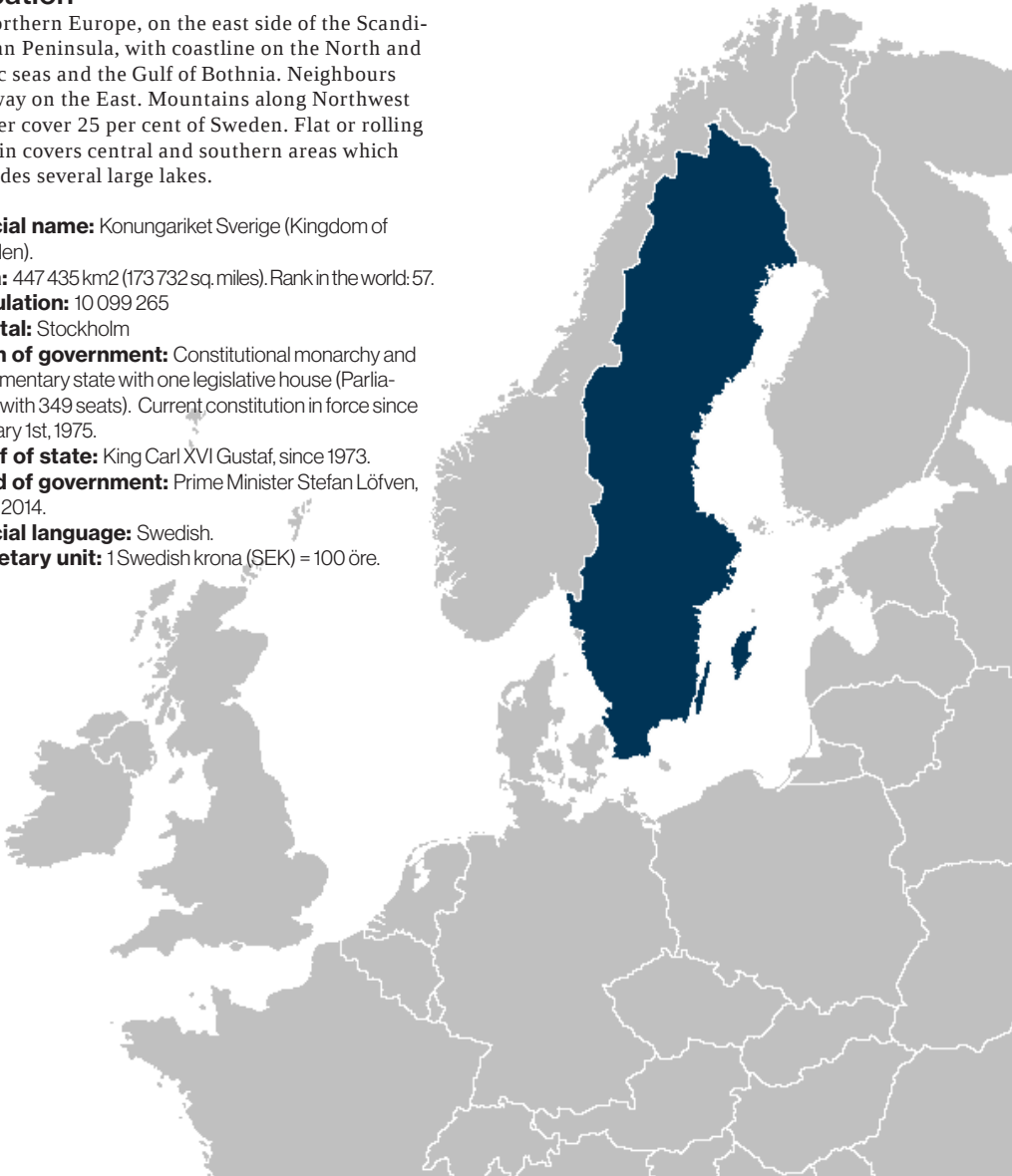
Form of government: Constitutional monarchy and parliamentary state with one legislative house (Parliament with 349 seats). Current constitution in force since January 1st, 1975.

Monetary unit: 1 Swedish krona (SEK) = 100 öre.





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SWEDISH OLYMPIC COMMITTEE



The Swedish Olympic Committee, SOC, is the supreme authority of Sweden in all Olympic matters. SOC comprises of 41 National Olympic Sports Associations as well as of 14 associations of “recognized sports”.

The Swedish Olympic Committee was established in 1913. The annual meeting following the Olympic Games appoints an Executive Board for a period of four years.

The main tasks for the Swedish Olympic Committee are the following:

- Development of top level sports.
- Talent detection and development of top level sports.
- Preparation for and selection to the Olympic Games.
- Responsible for the Swedish participation in the Olympic Games and the European Youth Olympic Festival (EYOF).
- Participation in the international work in boards, congresses, seminars and working groups within the Olympic Movement.
- Bilateral cooperation with other Olympic Committees.
- Demands for governmental subsidies.
- Olympic Marketing Program, national and international.
- Grants to the National Olympic Sports Associations from the marketing program.

Executive board

The executive board, implementing the SOC programme, meets 8-10 times a year. It consists of the President and nine members elected by the Annual Meeting and the IOC-members in Sweden.

Selection rules

The SOC Executive Board selects Olympic participants following proposals from and after discussions with the Olympic Sports Associations. To be selected as an Olympic competitor in the Olympics, an individual must show results sufficient to compete for places 1-8, and team results must be sufficient to compete for a place among the top eight. Teams qualifying for the Olympics in special Olympic qualifying rounds are automatically nominated for the games.

History

Svenska Gymnastikförbundet, in 1896, and a committee appointed by Sveriges Allmänna Idrottsförbund (later named Sveriges Centralförening för Idrottens Främjande), in 1900, were responsible for Swedish participation in the two first Olympic Games.

The first Swedish Olympic Committee was founded on November 2nd 1905, in order to prepare a team for the 1906 intercalated games.

“The Swedish Organising Committee” chaired by Colonel Viktor G. Balck, was dissolved at the

end of 1906. For participating in the 1908 games, a Swedish Committee, 1907-1908, was headed by HRH Prince Royal Gustaf Adolf (the future King Gustaf VI Adolf, reigning 1953-1973). Another committee, also led by Balck, was formed in 1909 to take the responsibility for the organisation of the Games of the Vth Olympiad in Stockholm and for the participation of the Swedish team in 1912.

In its present form SOK was formed on April 27th 1913, and the statutes now in force were adopted by the Annual Meeting 2017.

SWEDEN and the INTERNATIONAL OLYMPIC MOVEMENT

When Pierre de Coubertin invited personalities and organisations to support his move towards re-establishing the Olympic Games, he included the Royal Swedish Court.

On May 1st, 1894, the marshal of the Court wrote to Coubertin: "By order of HRH the Prince Royal of Sweden and Norway, I have the honour to inform you that HRH has the pleasure in accepting patronage of the International Athletics Congress from the 16th to the 24th June 1894 which you have so kindly offered him ..."

Having won this support, Coubertin then turned to the Central Gymnastic Institute in Stockholm, and of its Director, at the time Captain Viktor G. Balck (1844-1928). Balck became an honorary member of the Organising Committee for the 1894 Sorbonne Congress at which the International Olympic Committee was founded.

Attending the Congress were two Swedish delegates, representing Svenska Gymnastikförbundet,

Lieutenant Fredrik Bergh and Major Sten Adalrik Drakenberg.

Two IOC sessions have been held in Sweden and Stockholm, the 15th session in 1912 and the 41st session in 1947, the 2nd meeting of the Executive Board with the International Federations was also held in Stockholm. The IOC Executive Board has met in Stockholm three times in 1947, 1956 and 1988.

Gunilla Lindberg is currently member of the following IOC Commissions: Olympic Programme (1998-), Olympic Solidarity (2005-), Coordination for the Games of the XXXIII Olympiad Paris 2024 (2017-), Evaluation for the Youth Olympic Games 2022 (2018), Coordination for the Youth Olympic Games Dakar 2022 (2018-), Future Host Commission for the Olympic Winter Games (2019-).

Stefan Holm was elected as active athlete 2013.

SWEDEN AND THE OLYMPIC GAMES

Sweden has attended all Olympic Games with the sole exception of the St Louis Games in 1904.

In 1896, Henrik Sjöberg, a candidate of medicine, made the long journey from Stockholm to the Greek capital – partly on his own expense – to participate in four athletic events (high jump finishing 4th, long jump 6th, discus 7th, and 100 m where he was eliminated in the first round) and one gymnastic event (horse vault – placing unknown).

The first Swedish woman in Olympic competition was Elsa Wallenberg in the 1908 indoor tennis tournament in London.

The first Olympic medal was of gold and won by August Nilsson, Karl-Gustaf Staff and Gustaf Söderström together with three Danes in a tugwar team on July 15th 1900 in Paris.

Sweden has also attended all Olympic Winter games and was also represented in the winter sports events held in 1908 (figure skating) and 1920 (figure skating and ice hockey). The first Swedish competitor in the Winter Games was Elna Montgomery in women's figure skating in 1908 in London.

In the 31 Olympic Games 1896-2016 and the 23 Olympic Winter Games 1924-2018 more than 21 300 medals (including arts competition 1912-1948) has been awarded. Sweden has taken 668,5 of these medals (including 205,5 gold) and holds 9th place in the unofficial ranking.

Swedish former olympians form Swedish Olympians. The aim is to promote Swedish Olympic sport, and members can be part of marketing projects of the Swedish Olympic Committee.

The Games of the 5th Olympiad was held in Stockholm in 1912. The stadium built for these Games was also used for the Equestrian Games of the XVI Olympiad in 1956.

The Olympic Stadium is also the home for the Swedish Olympic Committee.

Stockholm was candidate city for the organisation of the Games of the XXVIII Olympiad in 2004.

Sweden has been bidding, unsuccessfully, for the Olympic Winter Games in 1984 (Göteborg), 1988 and 1992 (Falun), 1994, 1998, 2002 (Östersund) and 2026 (Stockholm-Åre).
